DAY 1 | BERLIN - COPENHAGEN

Your adventure begins as we head to the ancient **Viking fishing village of Copenhagen**. We arrive in time for a delicious dinner at the hostel. Afterwards feel free to acquaint yourself with the city at your leisure or experience its incredible nightlife. (D)

DAY 2 | COPENHAGEN

This morning your guide will take you on an orientation walk of the city. Spend the afternoon checking out the multiple museums, fountains, parks, and sculptures or visit the local anarchist community of **Freetown Christiania**. This evening we head to **Tivoli Gardens**, the second oldest amusement park in the world! (B)

DAY 3 | COPENHAGEN - OSLO

We head to the Norwegian capital of Oslo, where we'll visit the **Vigeland Sculpture Park** and go on an orientation walk to see some of the amazing sights in this world-class city. In your free time you can check out Frogner Park, which is home to the exquisite Frogner Manor as well as the Oslo City Museum. (B)

DAY 4 | OSLO

The day is yours to spend as you choose. Relax and recharge your batteries or head out into the city to find the hidden gems down the roads less travelled. Watch the sunset from the Opera House and enjoy the rest of your evening exploring Oslo's exciting nightlife. (B)

DAY 5 | OSLO - STOCKHOLM

This morning we head to the Swedish capital of Stockholm. Explore the city at your leisure. Be sure to visit the fabulous Vasa Museum with its 400-year-old wooden ship, the **Abba Museum**, and experience Stockholm's vibrant nightlife! (B)

DAY 6 | STOCKHOLM

Spend the morning marauding through the medieval streets of the Old Town on our included **Viking Walking Tour**, before a free afternoon to explore the Swedish capital and its many sights. This evening we head out for a couple of really cold ones on our optional excursion to an ice bar. (B)

DAY 7 | STOCKHOLM - TALLINN (OVERNIGHT CRUISE)

Catch your last glimpses of Stockholm before we board our ferry to Estonia. Enjoy a buffet dinner on board followed by karaoke as we cross the Baltic Sea! (B, D)

DAY 8 | TALLINN

We arrive in Tallinn and have an **orientation walk** to help you explore the Estonian capital with its medieval architecture, numerous churches, quirky bars and towering city walls. Immerse yourself in this amazing city and kick your Baltic adventure off in true style. (B)

DAY 9 | TALLINN - RIGA

Today we head to Latvia, with stops at the picturesque **seaside town of Parnu** and the **Sigulda bobsleigh track**. Once in Riga we will experience Latvia's warm hospitality. (B)

DAY 10 | RIGA

This morning explore Riga's Art Deco architecture, communist monuments and cobblestone streets, or just relax in one of the many local establishments for some food and drink during our afternoon of free time. (B)



THE PLACES YOU'LL GO

COPENHAGEN



The capital city of Denmark blends old fairy tales with flashy modern architecture and design. It may seem small by European standards, but offers excellent shopping, cultural and nightlife options!

INSTAGOLD: The incredibly colourful Nyhavn canal!

STOCKHOLM



For a city spread across 14 islands, Stockholm doesn't need to work too hard to be liked. From a dreamy Old Town to an ostentatious palace, and even a museum that celebrates musical group ABBA's history, there's something for everyone.

INSTAGOLD: Gamla Stan, the beautifully preserved historical centre.

DAY 11 | RIGA - VILNIUS

Next stop: Vilnius. En route we stop at the awe-inspiring **Hill of Crosses** and **Trakai Castle**, two must-see sights in Lithuania. (B)

DAY 12 | VILNIUS

A full day in Vilnius to explore its castles, museums, and student filled cafes. Take a trip to **the neighbourhood of Uzupis**, a popular area for local artists and renowned for its bohemian atmosphere. Tonight we have an included dinner so get ready to have a feast in true Lithuanian style. (B, D)

DAY 13 | VILNIUS - WARSAW

This morning we board our coach and traverse the gorgeous Baltic countryside towards Warsaw. Stretch your legs on a walk through the **historic Old Town** and see some of the sights on offer in Poland's capital city. (B)

DAY 14 | WARSAW - BERLIN

Today we end off where we began: Berlin! Join us for a final group outing to explore Berlin's famously eclectic nightlife! (B)

DAY 15 | BERLIN

Check-out is after breakfast. If you're joining us on our Hop-on Hop-off network, the next stop is Prague via Dresden! (B)

RIGA



A city with many faces, Riga is the creative and cultural centre of Latvia, and home to one in three Latvians. Famously known for its Art Nouveau and wooden architecture, the city's historical centre is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

INSTAGOLD: The imposing Freedom Monument.

VILNIUS



Lithuania's capital is known for its medieval Old Town, boasting cobblestoned streets lined with impressive baroque architecture. The alternative hotspot of the city, the neighbourhood of Uzupis, is renowned for its bohemian crowd and atmosphere.

INSTAGOLD: The cobblestoned streets and alleyways of the Old Town.
