

DAY 3 | CHRISTMAS DAY

Explore the snow-capped mountains and rugged Highlands before returning to a warm Victorian hotel for a massive **Christmas dinner**. Dance the food off with a **traditional Scottish Ceilidh**. Sounds fun, aye? (B, L, D)

DAY 4 | INVERNESS - LOCH NESS
