

Engaging The FoundationACCESS Trial Navigator Program



STEP 1

You, your staff or your patient would like to initiate the search for clinical trial options based on the results of the FoundationOne or FoundationOne Heme test



STEP 2

Contact Foundation Medicine's client services

STEP 3

Provide contact information, preferred method of contact and nature of request:

- General clinical trial search
- Targeted clinical trial search based on a specific genomic alteration
- Contact information for a specific clinical trial



STEP 4

Foundation Medicine's client services facilitate the transfer to EmergingMed



STEP 5

A Clinical Trial Navigator (CTN) from EmergingMed follows up and collects relevant clinical information to refine the search of clinical trials based on the FoundationOne or FoundationOne Heme results



STEP 6

Matched results and contact information for all relevant clinical trials is provided along with a consultation to help you filter through the results



STEP 7

The CTN follows up to identify and trouble shoot any barriers you encounter when referring your patient to a matched clinical trial site or connecting with a study investigator.



STEP 8

If a clinical trial is not right for your patient today, the CTN is available for future consultations

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Is FoundationOne or FoundationOne Heme testing required for utilizing this service?

A: Yes, the FoundationACCESS Trial Navigator service will merge the results of a patient's FoundationOne or FoundationOne Heme test with a brief clinical profile to identify relevant clinical trial matches. For the most accurate results, a patient should have the test before a clinical trial search is performed

Q: Is there a charge for this service?

A: No, the clinical trial navigation services are provided free of charge to the patient and health care providers by Foundation Medicine

Q: Where can I find basic information about clinical trials to help educate my patients?

A: The Clinical Trial Navigator is happy to provide your staff or your patient with any background information, education or clarification about clinical trials, the enrollment process and what to expect from participation in a clinical trial.

Q: Will the Clinical Trial Navigator recommend a clinical trial for my patient?

A: The Clinical Trial Navigator will not offer any medical advice, but will work with you or your patient to refine the list of relevant clinical trials according to patient or health care provider preferences such as location, trial phase or treatment type

Q: If I have already identified a clinical trial for my patient, can the service still help with the enrollment process?

A: Yes, the service can provide the most up-to-date contact information, trouble shoot any barriers you or your staff encounter and provide follow-up to facilitate connections with study sites


Q: How will my patient's clinical information be protected?

A: Any information shared with Foundation Medicine or EmergingMed will be done so in a secure, HIPPA-compliant manner that will ensure patient privacy and protection

Q: Which clinical trial database is used to conduct the search for relevant clinical trials?

A: Clinical trial searches are conducted using EmergingMed's proprietary clinical trials database which includes all trials listed on clinicaltrials.gov plus trial and site updates provided directly from trial sponsors and sites

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
